Adult Education allows people to connect in new and old ways. More than ever, people need connection. In this spirit we have two new features coming in 2024:

- 1. The "All About" series of classes consists of self-contained, one-session presentations or classes that *only meet once*. This is a great way to learn something new without committing to a long class. Some of them are on Zoom, some are in-person. We hope this series will grow! On our website, look for the "All About" category!
- 2. Make new friends! We are **partnering with RSU 24 Adult Education** to 'connect' with a larger community. We are sharing some classes that we think might round out our own local selection. You will be directed to contact RSU 24 to register for their classes.
- 3. Are the fees charged by Coursestorm for using a credit card refundable if the class is cancelled?
 - Unfortunately, no. This convenience charge cannot be refunded. If you want to avoid the processing fee, you can pay in person by cash or check, or you can mail the registration form to MDI Adult Ed (1081 Eagle Lake Rd, Bar Harbor ME 04609) with your check. Be sure to indicate that you are paying by check when you register for a class on the website. **Remember, your check or credit card payment secures your spot.**
- 4. If you **need to switch classes** (to one with the same cost) CALL US (288-4703) so we can transfer you without incurring any fees.
- 5. **No refunds will be made after a class begins.** If you need to cancel, please give us at least 48 hours' notice. Our enrichment program must be financially self-sustaining so if a class drops below the minimum number of students at the last minute, it risks the whole class being canceled. FYI, if a class is full, sign up for the waiting list.
- 6. Please note that last-minute classes that don't meet the cutoff date for the printing will be still added to the website.
- 7. Our classes are open to adults not currently enrolled in a k-12 school. If a student 16+ is interested in taking a class, please reach out to the Director for special permission.
- 8. Keep in mind that our **Zoom classes are open to all adults, far and near**. If you have a family member or friend who lives out of town or even out of state, they can join you in a class! Keep those connections strong! Plus, if you go out of town, you can still participate in Zoom classes.
- 9. A large part of our adult education mission is to help people **earn a high school credential**, **learn English**, **and/or prepare for college**. Please don't hesitate to contact us if you or someone you know could benefit from these programs.

If you're an adult without a high school diploma, the High School Equivalency Test (HiSET™) could be your route to improved career prospects, further education, and increased earnings potential. HiSET™ replaces the GED in Maine. Free for Maine Residents! Call or email us to enroll anytime!

HISETTM provides adults with the opportunity to obtain a high school equivalency certification with the same legal standing as a high school diploma. Through a pre-testing, preparation, and testing program, it allows test-takers to demonstrate proficiency of the academic skills and knowledge expected by employers and post-secondary institutions. HiSETTM consists of five subtests:

- Language arts- Reading
- Language Arts- Writing
- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Studies



The National Digital Equity Center offers free, online, interactive technology classes on a wide variety of topics and devices that range from 1-3 hours long. Classes are either held at a physical location (such as Adult Ed or a local library) or online using your own computer.

Registration and Payment Options:

- 1. ONLINE 24/7 at **www.mdi.coursestorm.com** using credit card or send in check. (We prefer check for classes over \$50 when possible.)
- 2. Mail or call-in registration form with cash or check.

Your payment reserves your space in the class. There is a \$30.00 charge for returned checks.

Programs may be canceled due to insufficient enrollments. Once you have registered and paid, you will be contacted if there is a change in schedule via email. Zoom links will go out 24-48 hrs. prior to the class. Be sure to check your spam folder before contacting us about your confirmation that comes from Coursestorm once we process your information. TIP: Check email for any changes before class starts.

<u>Age:</u> Unless otherwise noted in the course description, courses are open to individuals 17 years and older who are not attending elementary or high school. In some cases, the Director may allow waivers. Please contact us.

<u>Refunds:</u> If Adult Ed cancels a class, a refund will be issued. If you withdraw before the class begins, refunds minus service fees will be made. Many Zoom classes are recorded so ask us about this before cancelling. **No refunds will be made after the class starts**. If a student is dissatisfied with a class, he or she may write a letter or email to the Director with an explanation. Our goal is 100% satisfaction.

<u>Cancellations:</u> With the online classes, there will be fewer reasons to cancel classes. Power outages and internet interruptions will be the most common issues. Please contact us or your instructor if you are having difficulty with accessing classes or if you miss a class due to circumstances at home.


